Sub: Telugu as compulsory language in Schools for Classes I & VI-2018-19

Dear Student/Parent,

The Telangana State has introduced Telugu as compulsory language in Schools in Class I and VI during the academic year 2018-19 and shall continue for further classes progressively as given below.

	Telugu as 2 nd or 3 rd Language is compulsory in the below classes in the years mentioned	
Year	Classes	Classes
2018-19	I	VI
2019-20	I & II	VI & VII
2020-21	I to III	VI to VIII
2021-22	I to IV	VI to IX
2022-23	I to V	VI to X

Accordingly the following language scheme is applicable for 2018-19.

Class 1 : If Hindi is 2nd Language, then Telugu is introduced as 3rd Language.

If Telugu is 2nd Language, then Hindi is introduced as 3rd Language.

Class 5 : 3rd Language in Class V is discontinued.

Class 6 : If Hindi is 2nd Language, then Telugu is introduced as 3rd Language

instead of Sanskrit (Sanskrit as 3rd Lang is discontinued).

If Telugu is 2nd Language, then Hindi is continued as 3rd Language.

Syllabus: Telugu Alphabet/sight words will be taught in Classes 1 & 6 till the textbooks for 3rd Language Telugu are made available by the State Government.

Principal
