
Our school provides quality education for the over all development of the personality of the child:











Ramzan Celebrations


<u>Krishnajanmashtami</u> Celebrations










Pride Author





fascinating period in history marked by cultural richness, architectural marvels, and political intrigue. To bring this era


to life, our class 7C conducted a role play that delved into the various aspects of Mughal society, economics ,politics, and culture.

Aims: Students learn about the new term miscible and immiscible liquids.

Materials needed: Different types of liquids (honey, ink, vinegar, oil, water) etc.

Activity presentation time: 4 minutes group presentation.

Procedure: Students brought different types of liquids such as honey, ink, vinegar, oil, water etc and performed by dissolving in one another and discussing the concept of miscible and immiscible liquids.





Leaning outcome: Students understood the difference between soluble substances and miscible liquids/ insoluble substances and Immiscible liquids



Grade: VI

Subject: Science

Lesson: Electricity and circuits

Concept of Activity: To prepare a working model of a closed circuit.

Skills developed: Creative and problem solving.

Aims: Students learn about the conductor and insulator materials. They learn how to connect the wire from a battery to the other devices like bulb or switch etc.

Materials needed:

Battery, safety pin, wires, cardboard, bulb or fan, connector etc.

Activity presentation time: 30 minutes individual presentation.



Procedure: Students brought the required materials and made a closed circuit, they also discussed



the function of every part used in making a model.

Leaning outcome: Students learn the benefit of using a switch, and also precautions to be taken while handling any electrical appliances.



Grade: V

Subject: Science

Concept of Activity: Requirements of protein in growing children.

Skills developed: Presentation and communication

Aims: Students learn the importance of protein for a healthy growth.

Students also illustrate some aspects of not having a protein rich diet.

Materials needed: sprouts and some spices.

Activity presentation time: 3 minutes per child.

Procedure: Students were asked to bring any protein rich snacks and present their preparation and

importance.

Leaning outcome: Student activities are generally designed to allow students to become more involved and share their understanding of the concept taught.

Activity also enhances an Individual's personal growth.
















































The Nari-Sari Walkathon 2024 was a delightful event held on the morning of March 22nd, 2024.
